

The Venue - Gaunts House

Gaunts House is set in 2,000 acres of beautiful Dorset countryside where you can see the resident community of deer, and explore rolling fields filled with many majestic, ancient trees. The house is an 18th century mansion, with large comfortable workshop rooms, log fires and windows looking out over the sweeping grounds. The bedrooms are comfortable but not luxurious.

All meals are home cooked and vegetarian, served in the dining room. Special diets (vegan, gluten, wheat and dairy-free only) can be catered for if requested at the time of booking.
